The Fowler Village Council met Monday, July 11, 2016 at 7:00 PM with and President Pro Tem David Klein presiding.

The pledge of allegiance was given to the flag. Roll was called and a quorum reported. Present were: Greg Halfmann, Rick Fink, John Childers, Mike Porter, John Rademacher, and Rhonda Feldpausch. Absent: Roy Smith and Vernon J. Thelen.

**BOARD ACTION:** Trustee Fink moved, supported by Trustee Childers, to approve the agenda as presented. Motion carried.

**BOARD ACTION:** Trustee Fink moved, supported by Trustee Porter, to approve the minutes of the June 13, 2016 regular meeting as presented. Motion carried.

**BOARD ACTION:** Trustee Porter moved, supported by Trustee Childers, to approve payment of \$ 34,159.01 from the General Fund, \$2,827.35 from the Water O & M Fund, and \$1,540.80 from the Sanitary O & M Fund. Motion carried.

**BOARD ACTION:** Trustee Fink moved, supported by Trustee Porter, to approve zoning permit #AB 2016-01 submitted by Jerome and Ann Pohl and AB #2016-02 submitted by Ken and Jamie Lacksheide. Motion carried.

No one present.

**BOARD ACTION:** Trustee Fink moved, supported by Trustee Childers, to approve the Treasurer's report. Motion carried.

Meeting August 8, 2016 to review Special Use Permit Application for Wieber Lumber.

On the subject of 11368 W. Kent Street, Clerk Feldpausch contacted legal counsel regarding the proper procedure involved that would meet land transfer/combination rules and zoning rules. Legal counsel was made aware that the Village Council was in favor of the transaction providing compliance with Village of Fowler ordinances. Counsel stated that an argument could be made for or against the transaction; but given the Village Council desire to allow, while unusual, would be supported by legal counsel. At the time the Simons sell the 3+ acres to the Beckers, wording provided by legal counsel will be included on the deed for the 18+ acres and a copy will be provided to the village. Approval for the transaction was granted and the Land Combination/Transfer document was signed by the Zoning Administrator.

Vern Feldpausch reported on the following issues:

Foundation and flatwork to be completed soon. Framing to begin in August.

**BOARD ACTION:** Trustee Fink moved, supported by Trustee Porter, to adopt Res #2016-01 which reads as follows:

## A RESOLUTION TO EXEMPT THE VILLAGE FROM THE REQUIREMENTS OF PUBLIC ACT 152 FOR THE NEXT SUCCEEDING YEAR

WHEREAS Public Act 152 of 2011, passed by the legislature and signed into law by the governor, was designed to lessen the burden of employee health care costs on public employers; and

WHEREAS, communities are given four options for complying with the requirements of Act 152, depending on the impact of the Act on the employees of each community; and

WHEREAS, the four options available to the village are:

- 1) apply the hard cap (capped dollar amount each government employer may pay towards an employee's health care costs;
- 2) adopt by majority vote the 80%-20% cost-sharing model;
- 3) elect not to follow the act:
- 4) opt out of (exempt itself from) the cost-sharing model as set forth in the act and revisit it prior to the next plan year.

WHEREAS, the Village Council has decided to exempt itself from the requirements of the act for the next succeeding year; and

WHEREAS, the Village Council recognizes that such exemption requires a 2/3 majority vote of the Village Council:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Village Council for Village of Fowler hereby exempts itself from the requirements of Public Act 152 of 2011 for the next succeeding year; BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Village Council for the Village of Fowler acknowledges its responsibility to revisit its options and responsibility under Public Act 152 of 2011 in one year.

Motion carried.

John Rademacher, Treasurer, will provide a spreadsheet providing information outlining yearly costs of village operations versus special projects.

**BOARD ACTION:** Trustee Fink moved, supported by Trustee Childers, to accept sidewalk bids from Antes Concrete in the amount of \$2.67/sq ft for 4" and \$3.13/sq ft for 6". Motion carried.

Note: Per Fee Schedule: a 15% material charge will be added to bid price at time of billing.

**BOARD ACTION:** Trustee Porter moved, supported by Trustee Fink, to approve sending sidewalk installation notifications to Community Developers, Francis Thelen, Derek Koenigsknecht, Brett Thelen, Jerome Pohl, Erwin Pline, Jodie Watts and Mike Schaefer. Motion carried.

**BOARD ACTION:** Trustee Childers moved, supported by Trustee Fink, to deny reimbursement request from Bill Simmon due to lack of prior approval. Motion carried.
